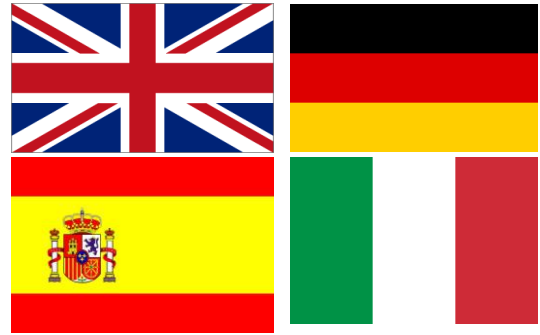

DIFFÉRENCES BETWEEN FRENCH AND AUSTRALIAN SCHOOLS

In Australia, we start school at 8:30 or 9:00am and we finish at 3:30pm. This is the same for five days in a row – Monday to Friday. This early finish time usually allows students to participate in co-curricular activities after school either at school or at a local club.

Australian students have to wear uniforms, which usually consist of a shirt and a tie for girls and boys, a skirt for girls and trousers for boys, and all students wear black school shoes. The relationship between students and teachers are slightly more informal, the students do not stand up when the teacher enters the room. At lunchtime in Australian schools, students are not permitted to leave the school and most students bring their lunch to school. There are canteens but usually they do not have a large choice and are expensive.

There are only two types schools in Australia – Primary (grade prep to grade 6) and Secondary (year 7 to year 12). Classes are usually around 50 minutes to an hour long but this depends on the school.

In years 10-12 (lycée equivalent) in Australia, there is a lot more freedom to choose a wide range of subjects that you are interested in. For example there are no sections like 'literary' or 'science', you are able to study Science, languages and creative subjects at the same time for your VCE (Baccalauréat equivalent).
