I. School information

1. Access

Access only permitted at the **Avenue du Mont Héry entrance** and at the following hours:

In the morning

- From 07.30 am to 8.15 am
(except on Mondays from 7.30 am to 8.30 am)
- From 08.45 am to 09.00 am
- From 09.45 am to 10.00 am
- From 10.45 am to 11.00 am
- From 11.45 am to 12.00

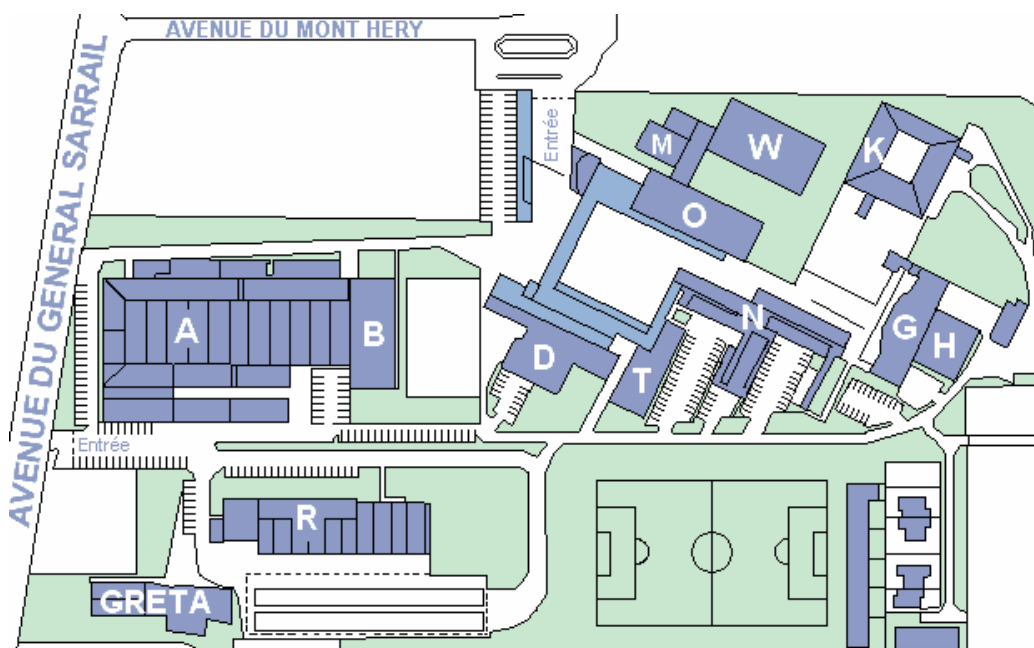
In the afternoon

- From 12.45 to 1.00 pm
- From 1.45 pm to 2.00 pm
- From 2.45 pm to 5.00 pm
- From 3.45 pm to 4.00 pm
- From 4.45 pm to 5.00 pm
(except on Fridays from 4.30 pm to 5.00 pm)
- From 17h30 to 6.00 pm

Regulations

Students have to **identify** to the person in charge of the check in and present their **canteen access cards**.
Driving and parking in the school a premise is forbidden to students except if they are boarders.
Free parking area is available outside school (rue de la fraternité)

All students have to abide by the school rules **including students in a higher education course.**



2. Semi- boarding and full-time boarding

The self-service restaurant is open five days in the week at lunch time from 11.30 am to 1.15 pm. Changes in your canteen registration terms will be accepted exclusively in the first two weeks in September. No change during semester will be accepted except upon a request letter before Christmas holiday and spring holiday.

Day students may at the canteen occasionally with a canteen pass-card with available credit. Canteen and accommodation services are provided by the school but maybe subject to suspension in case of nonpayment or improper behavior. Canteen and accommodation charges are fixed by the Regional education board per calendar year. Payment is a fixed amount based on a 36 week period and due per term. Payment is possible by bank check, bank transfer, and direct debit from your bank account or online on the school website.

Students receive a magnetic badge upon their arrival to access the school premises and the canteen. They are expected to keep it until they leave school. Replacing it will be charged. The hall of residencies opens from Monday to Friday.

Enrollment may take place already in June depending on vacancies and upon the delivery of a certificate of radiation by your former school.

The number of rooms being limited priority goes to full-time students.

Permission for out of school parties may be considered but are to be requested by letter beforehand.

School residents may park their cars on the school premises but only on a strictly limited area.

A room dedicated to the higher education students' community is located in building A (A074).
Access requires a 5 euro subscription per year.
It is regulated by the students themselves.

Your course includes mandatory work placement periods :

- BTS TPL : 7 weeks in the first year and 5 weeks in the second year
- BTS CPRP : 2 + 8 weeks in the first year

These training periods are an obligation for your graduation.

If you register with a work – study contract, you have to submit an attendance form for each class and provide a sick note for your employer in case of absence due to illness.

ECTS credits in all competences are delivered each semester and will appear on your school reports.
A maximum of 30 ECTS will be granted per semester and a final recap given at the end of your school training.

You can do your work placement abroad and thus enjoy the opportunity of an incredibly enriching experience.

If you consider this option, guidance and counseling will be provided. Help for language training, paperwork or grants, will be offered before mobility. An intern ship advisor will assist you on location abroad. Your experience will be assessed and valued as an asset in your academic career.
